At a recent political meeting in Downpatrick, a member of the audience videoed Mr Wells making some remarks about same sex marriages and the raising of children within such arrangements. In the video clip, Mr Wells says "the facts show you certainly don't bring a child up in a homosexual relationship". He went on to claim children were "far more likely to be abused or neglected" in "non-stable" marriages.

These words have caused a political uproar!

Sinn Fein, the advocates and defenders of murder as a political tool, have condemned Mr Wells and called for his resignation. Other Northern Ireland parties have likewise lined up to condemn him. The SDLP, the Alliance party, the Ulster Unionists all joined the chorus. Nick Clegg, the doyen of liberal thinking, added his halfpenny's worth by saying: "The mask has slipped", accusing the DUP of being "truly backward-looking" in its views.

Peter Robinson, Mr Wells' party leader, gave him support but also said: Mr Wells' remarks were "not our view and nor will it ever be our view."

Of course Mr Wells also apologised. He said: "I accept that one line of what I said caused offence and deep concern amongst members of the audience and beyond," he said. "I regret having wrongly made that remark about abuse and I'm sorry those words were uttered. The comment did not reflect my view, nor that of my party."

Whatever it was that Mr Wells said, one thing is sure - no one will be permitted to disparage the sodomite lifestyle without provoking a storm of opposition.

Irrespective of that, I wish to state that the lifestyle of the sodomite is, in Bible terms, a perversion and a deviant manner of life. Furthermore, the abuse of children arises out of a perversion of mind and heart linked to sodomy. Like it or lump it, sodomites have in their moral camp those who are abusers of children.
