It is the duty of the servant of God to warn of coming judgement.

"But if the watchman see the sword come, and blow not the trumpet, and the people be not warned; if the sword come, and take any person from among them, he is taken away in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at the watchman's hand. So thou, O son of man, I have set thee a watchman unto the house of Israel; therefore thou shalt hear the word at my mouth, and warn them from me. When I say unto the wicked, O wicked man, thou shalt surely die; if thou dost not speak to warn the wicked from his way, that wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at thine hand," Ezekiel 33:6-8.

A watchman must be in contact and communion with the Lord and 'hearing' His Word!

The warning he must give is strong and stern! "When I say unto the wicked, O wicked man, thou shalt surely die." Consequently it is not a welcome message and the messenger will suffer reproach.

But better that than finding the blood of the unwarned wicked required by the Lord at your hand!

On the plains of Mamre, the Lord visited Abraham and made known His mind regarding Sodom.

"And the LORD said, Shall I hide from Abraham that thing which I do; seeing that Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him? For I know him, that he will command his children and his household after him, and they shall keep the way of the LORD, to do justice and judgment; that the LORD may bring upon Abraham that which he hath spoken of him. And the LORD said, Because the cry of Sodom and Gomorrah is great, and because their sin is very grievous; I will go down now, and see whether they have done altogether according to the cry of it, which is come unto me; and if not, I will know," Genesis 18:17-21.

There is a great need today for men who have an awareness of how it is God's sees events in this world and what is in His mind by way of retribution. All too many seem to be like Lot. He appears to be unaware, unconcerned and content to be so, with regards the approaching judgment from the Lord upon the wickedness of Sodom.
