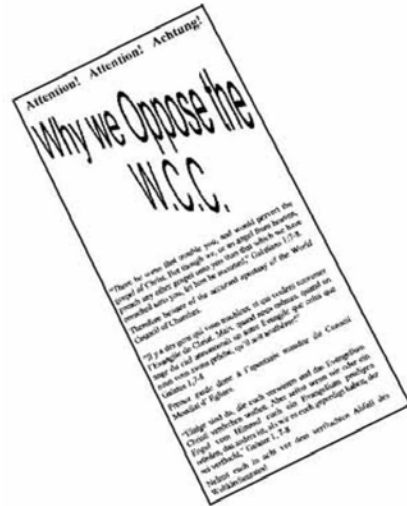




The Burning Bush—Online article archive

Protest leaflet distributed in Amsterdam



The following is the main text of a leaflet, printed in English, French and German, that was handed out by protesters outside the WCC meeting.

This is being achieved by the subversion of the historic Reformed and Protestant Faith, in particular the fundamental doctrine of Justification that SALVATION IS BY FAITH ALONE IN JESUS CHRIST ALONE; and to substitute the Reformed Faith with an ecumenical statement of faith acceptable to the Roman Catholic Church which continues to reject that Salvation is by faith alone in Jesus Christ alone.

Furthermore the World Council of Churches and the Roman Catholic Church are already working together, under the auspices of the Joint Working Group and the Faith and Order Commission of the World Council of Churches, to progress the "Ecumenical Movement", of which they are

all now a part, by moving the member churches of the World Council of Churches ever closer to the acceptance of the Pope as the head of one World Communion of Churches. Thus the World Council of Churches is compromising its member churches on matters of faith, doctrine and church government.

Therefore the British Council of Protestant Christian Churches calls upon all who do not agree with this betrayal of the Protestant and Reformed Faith to oppose the World Council of Churches' programme of apostasy by separating from it in obedience to God's word which states: Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness? And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel? And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, 2 Corinthians 6: 14-17.
