An evil scourge advancing fast



In Genesis 19:4-11 and also in Judges chapters 19 and 20, we have set before us the aggressive brutishness of the sodomite. It cannot surprise anyone that, when there is an abandoning of decency to the extent that sodomites do, there is little likelihood of the gentler expressions of decency such as *peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness* (Galatians 5:22) abounding. The sodomite has become increasingly more aggressive in

his demands to be accepted as an equal by those who live according to the basic human tenet of heterosexuality. Sodomites not only demand the right to live in complete defiance of God, but they would have all others endorse their filthiness by equating their abnormal, sub-human behaviour with the life-style ordained of God.

The aggressiveness displayed outside the home of Lot in the city of Sodom is increasingly manifested today. This is not surprising since one of the less well publicised “enshrinements” of the Belfast Agreement, is the promotion of equality of opportunity, with regard to issues such as sexual orientation.

A recent report by the Northern Ireland Human Rights Commission claims that the sodomite community is discriminated against in areas such as criminal law, employment, partnership, family life and healthcare. The problem is particularly evident, according to the report, in family and partnership legislation where same-sex couples are not regarded as parents. This, the report says, can have implications for the education and healthcare of the children of these couples. It is a simple biological fact that “same-sex couples” as they are euphemistically termed, cannot have children! It is misleading and patronising of the Commission to use such an expression.

One of the authors, Mr Dermot Feenan, lecturer in law at the University of Ulster, described the report as a “landmark document” which he hoped would lead to a more inclusive society. Commenting on the report, Mr Brice Dickson, chief commissioner of the Northern Ireland Human Rights Commission, said he hoped attention would be paid to the report's contents. “I hope that early changes in law and policy will result, so that lesbian, gay and bisexual people can genuinely feel more included in our society,” he said. The report recommends the Northern Ireland Assembly should set up a task force to address concerns faced by the gay community.

Scotland

In Scotland, according to a Daily Mail report of July 24th, it has been claimed that teachers who extol the benefits of marriage over sodomite and lesbian relationships could soon face disciplinary action. The General Teaching Council in Scotland, which regulates the profession, is said to be about to draft a new code of conduct, along similar lines to one in England. It is expected to insist that teachers tell pupils that homosexual relationships and married life are on a par. Family campaigners, who monitored the code of conduct being

introduced down south (England) earlier this year, fear teachers who flout the rules could be penalised. They claim that, if introduced, the new code would also be used to prevent schools from teaching that marriage is a better way of bringing up children than an unmarried relationship. Simon Calvert, of the Christian Institute, said: "This code will go beyond preaching tolerance to actually directing teachers. Those who believe homosexuality is wrong may end up fearing for their jobs."

The General Teaching Council oversees 76,000 teachers in Scotland, who have to be registered with it before they are allowed to work in state schools. It has the power to sit in judgment on teachers who break its codes of conduct and, if necessary, strike them from its register preventing them from practising.

Virtually every bastion of decency has fallen to the aggressiveness of the pro-sodomite lobby. Most ecumenical churches accept sodomite "clerics" either covertly or, as in most cases, overtly. Recently, same-sex "marriages" were moved on to liberal church agendas. Some countries, such as Germany and the Netherlands, have legalised formal same-sex "marriages." British Prime Minister, Tony Blair, has crowded sodomites and lesbians into senior positions within his administration, thus sanctioning further "normalisation" of the abnormal. In all these innovations, we see the lengthening shadows of antichristianity and the latter-day apostasy falling upon our society.
