## Election of Sodomite as bishop seen as a "threat" by Church of Ireland

In a joint statement, Church of Ireland Primate, Robin Eames and Archbishop of Dublin, John Neill, have reacted to the recent news of the election of Dr. Gene Robinson as the Bishop of New Hampshire in the USA, by saying that they "regret the threat to the unity of the Anglican Communion caused by this election. . ." They went on to say that the election raised grave issues for the whole Anglican Communion, of which the Church of Ireland is an integral part. same sex relationships and that they hoped to issue a discussion document. An article in the Belfast Telegraph, of August 21st, said that the two Archbishops underlined that Anglicans had a duty "to maintain as high a degree of unity as possible with those from whom we differ."
