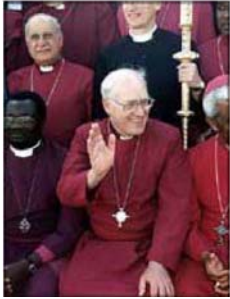

### Anglicanism's Dirty Politics



Anglican bishops from Africa, gathered for the ten-yearly Lambeth Conference of bishops, called on their counterparts in the western churches to repent of their sexual liberalism. They accused them of betraying the Bible on the issues of sexuality. The conference voted 526 to 70 with 45 abstentions in favour of a resolution which said that sodomy is "incompatible with Scripture." The resolution opposes the blessing and ordination of Anglican sodomites and lesbians and also urged chastity before marriage. This resolution has been a blow against the liberal wing of the Anglican Communion.

But the fight back was soon underway. One insider at the conference is quoted in the press as saying that the whole affair was run just like a political system. "People have definitely been playing dirty politics." A leading liberaliser, Richard Holloway, Bishop of Edinburgh, angrily responded to the vote. He claimed that American conservatives won over Africans by throwing barbecue parties. He called the Archbishop of Canterbury, George Carey, "pathetic" and accused him of not giving leadership. Holloway said that he felt "lynched" at the conference. "It is very difficult to be a lesbian and gay Christian. It takes enormous courage."



We have to say to Bishop Holloway that it is not merely difficult to be a sodomite and a Christian, it is impossible. Sodomy is an abomination, anathematised by God and condemned by His Word. No one can claim to love the Lord Jesus Christ as Saviour and yet walk in darkness and such abominable defiance of His law. *If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth*, 1 John 1:6.

Following the decision of the conference, which according to reports is not binding on Anglicans anyway, George Carey made a call for unity. He said that the decision does not exclude sodomites from "the church". The presiding bishop of the American church, Frank Griswold, has refused to say that he would stop ordaining sodomites. George Carey said that the decision would improve relations with Muslims and Roman Catholics. He made no reference to relations with God!!

#### ***Deal***

Part of the deal done before the vote appears to be that western bishops would turn a blind eye to polygamy among African "converts" while the Africans would "forgive" the Western Church for its high divorce rate. Had they been able to work out a deal on sodomy, doubtless they would. Such is the way of doing things in Antichrist's church!



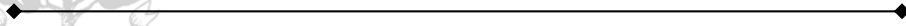
