### Introducing Hannah!



**Hannah Fallows is a little girl who is known and loved far outside the usual circle of acquaintances of a young lady of 3 years of age in September past! Hannah suffers from Spinal Muscular Atrophy and, in consequence, is known by many of God's people who have had a prayerful interest in her wellbeing.**

Her illness has greatly limited her mobility because her muscle development has been impaired. A new development in battery-driven wheel chairs will give Hannah the physical support she requires and enable her to move independently about the home and, consequently, this would greatly enhance Hannah's quality of life. She is a happy little girl with a ready smile despite all she has been through in her three short years, but the purchase of this chair (it's called a Koala electric wheel-chair) would enable her to enter into activities, within the home and outside, presently beyond her.

Our congregation in Kilskeery has just launched a fund to purchase the chair. It will cost nearly £8000. A deposit for £2000 has been paid, and the chair, which must be modified to suit Hannah's particular needs, will be delivered, God willing, about 6 weeks from now. Would you care to help? Already, gifts have been sent in, even though this is really the first public announcement of the project. Ballygowan Free Presbyterian congregation where Hannah's family attended before moving to the Kesh area, in one Lord's Day, received gifts amounting to nearly £2200. I have no doubt that the remaining £5800 will quickly come in.
