N I Department of Health, Social Services and Public Safety funds sodomite organisation to the tune of over £230,000 in the last 5 years!!!

In answer to a question submitted by a Christian to the DHSSPS under the "Freedom of Information Act", it has been disclosed that over the last five years the Department has funded the organisation, "The Rainbow Project", to the tune of over £230,000.

The details of the grants are listed below. The Minister presently in charge of the Department is Mr Edwin Poots MLA. He took up his post in May of this year. Mr. Poots is a member of the Free Presbyterian Church and it remains to be seen if he will continue with this ungodly funding scheme.

The organisation defines itself in the following manner:—

"The Rainbow Project is a health organisation that works to improve the physical, mental & emotional health of gay, bisexual and non-heterosexual men in Northern Ireland."

The grants given by the Department of Health, Social Services and Public Safety to the Rainbow Project have provided a core grant towards the Project's central administrative costs. The grant is used as a contribution towards the salary of the Director's post.

The ill-health suffered by sodomites is a direct result of their chosen life-style. It is the out-working of that referred to in Galatians 6:7-8. "Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting." And of the words of Romans 1:26-27, "For this cause God gave them up unto vile affections: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature: And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another; men with men working that which is unseemly, and receiving in themselves that recompence of their error which was meet."

It must be said that any measures taken to alleviate the consequences of this sinful life-style must be seen as an encouragement of the lifestyle and therefore a defying of God since He defines such as an abomination. "Thou shalt not lie with mankind, as with womankind: it is abomination." Leviticus 18:22, KJV.

Is not this a scandalous misuse of public funds to aid those who suffer the consequences of their own folly and disobedience to God and that especially in a time of recession-imposed stringencies which entail curbs of vital services to the general community?

I note that on the website of the Rainbow Project the DHSSPS and Health and Social Care Trusts are listed as funders. Pursuit of the Freedom of Information Act I request a breakdown of all funding provided by

(a) the Department of Health, Social Services and Public Safety and

(b) Social Care Trusts to the Rainbow Project in each of the last five years. Please also specify for what purpose such funding was provided in each case.

A copy of the information requested at part A and held by this Department is set out below. I understand also that you have been advised to contact the appropriate Health and Social Care Trusts in relation to part B of your request.

DHSSPS Response:

The Department of Health, Social Services and Public Safety provides a core grant to the Rainbow Project towards its central administrative costs. The grant is used as a contribution towards the salary of the Director's post. Funding provided for this purpose by the Department to the Rainbow Project in each of the last five years is set out below:

2006/07	£30,000
2007/08	£30,880
2008/09	£31,652
2009/10	£32,443
2010/11	£32,443

In addition, the Department provided a two year project grant towards a Sexual and Physical Health outreach project, to fund an Outreach Co-ordinator post. The post-holder coordinated and supported the provision of a range of health outreach services. Funding provided for the project by the Department to the Rainbow Project is set out below:

2006/07	£41,875
2007/08	£42,992
