The Lies and Deceit of Tony Blair

For decades, the unionist people of Ulster have endured an unremitting campaign of lies and deceit from their government in London and its lackeys here in Northern Ireland. No weapons found

So far, coalition troops have searched all but two of 19 suspected sites on their priority list, to no avail. No finds have emerged from searches of 45 of 68 sites thought to offer clues for banned weapons. Three mobile laboratories have been found, but none contained chemical or biological weapons.

The failure of coalition forces to find weapons of mass destruction in Iraq questions Tony Blair’s case for war, says former cabinet minister, Robin Cook. Mr Cook, who resigned as Commons leader on the eve of war, referred to the weapons of Saddam Hussein as the “fabled” weapons. Donald Rumsfeld, US Secretary of Defence, has recently suggested that the weapons were all destroyed before the war!! He said this may explain why such weapons were not used against coalition forces during the recent conflict. For many Labour MPs, the truth that they were deliberately deceived by their leader is bitter. Mr. Colin Challen, who joined the rebels in the first Iraq war vote in Parliament, but abstained on the final vote, is one of the Labour backbenchers now doubting the basis for war. Mr Challen told

the BBC 'Today' programme: "By now we would have expected to have seen a lot more evidence but the evidence has been so scant as to be almost non-existent." "It was not on the basis of finding some clapped out old chemical mobile laboratory that we were prepared to send our forces into battle." Let us welcome Mr Challen and his friends to the world of real politics in modern Britain!
