Special "Web Site" Report on Ballyclare Protest



Some of those who gathered to distribute tracts and to protest at the presence of a Roman Catholic priest singing in the Presbyterian church.

On Friday 12 May 2006, a concert took place in the Irish Presbyterian Church. The concert featured Ballyclare Male voice choir - (a non Christian choir) and the guest soloist who was invited was 'Father' Eugene O'Hagan - a Roman Catholic Priest from the chapel in the town!

A number of men and women from the Free churches in Ballyclare, Newtownabbey, and Martyrs Memorial, who were willing to take their stand for the truth in this evil day of apostasy, gathered to protest outside the concert venue.

A leaflet which had been specially prepared by Dr. Ian Paisley for the protest, about the Ballyclare Presbyterian minister inviting the Priest was offered to all going in the concert. The leaflet was entitled: "Breaking Solemn Vows brings Gods Wrath!"
