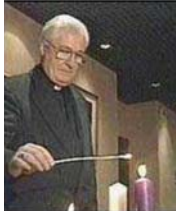

Scottish Cardinal scoffs at Protestants



Cardinal Winning...boasting of Rome's victory

On the eve of the 50th anniversary of his ordination as a priest, he said that other churches would have to give way and accept bishops. Rome would not shift on doctrine or the seven sacraments.

The cardinal suggested that the Reformation in Scotland took place more because of the people who were in power than over the issue of doctrine, and therefore, a return to Rome in these days of ecumenical understanding was inevitable.

A spokesman of the Cardinal mocked the idea of opposition from the Free Presbyterian Church of Scotland, predicting that they may well die out in the next century.

The future of Romanism is more accurately predicted in Revelation 17:16-18. Were the Cardinal to understand these verses, he would see that the future does not appear so bright for his brand of religion!
