"Moment of Madness"



Welsh Secretary of State, Ron Davies, has resigned after being robbed on Clapham Common, one of London's more notorious meeting places for sodomites, by those whom he says he met while out walking and decided to accompany to an apartment for dinner. He called his actions a "moment of madness."
