The Lutheran Church of Norway has made history by appointing to a parish a sodomite priest living openly with another man.

The priest will work in Majorstua, a suburb of Oslo. His appointment was narrowly approved by the Oslo Bishops' Council, with four members voting in favour, three against. The council is the ruling body for the diocese of Oslo, capital of Norway. Like other Scandinavian countries, Norway is often considered a liberal country on issues such as sexuality. But the decision has caused some conflict within the Church of Norway, the country's biggest denomination, and debate is still continuing.
