Changes at Kilskeery Independent Christian School



Demolition of the old classrooms underway.

Mrs Ann Foster, BA, has been the principal of Kilskeery Free Presbyterian Church school since its founding in September 1979.

She retired from her post at the end of the school term in June past. She hopes to continue teaching in some capacity within the school for a little time yet.

Her place has been taken by Miss Amanda Dane BA. She joined the school staff as our first trainee teacher in January 1988. She has been Vice-Principal in the school for several years. Miss Dane has taken up her duties at the beginning of this new school year.

Classrooms

A 1500 sq ft double classroom unit has been added to our school. It replaces two mobile classrooms which served the school for nearly 20 years.

The old structures were torn down and the new structure erected well in advance of the start of the new school term.

The unit has two large and bright classrooms plus a kitchen area and a very sizeable book store.

Doubtless it will be much appreciated by both pupils and staff.

The whole project will cost about £45,000. It is expected that the total cost will be covered without incurring debt.
